Whether painting in her Brooklyn studio or roaming amidst the medieval artworks at The Met Cloisters, artist Naudline Pierre reframes traditional representations of religion and spirituality, finding freedom in a world of her own making—where the airborne and earthbound coexist and cooperate.

"Fantasy for me is survival," says Naudline Pierre in the film. "It's not just pleasure, it's essential. It has been for my whole life."

"Making this film was akin to being granted access to Naudline's realm," says Haimy Assefa, the film's director. "Her embrace of fantasy not only influenced our cinematography but also sparked experimental elements within the film. We seized cinematic opportunities to warp reality at times, inviting viewers on a journey into the fantastical."
